- Visual/Physical Assessment (stream geometry, substrate size, embeddedness)
- Water Quality Indicators (water temp and water clarity)
- Benthic macroinvertebrates (family level ID)
- Standard Photographs

*Each monitoring day takes about 3 - 4 hours in total. You will monitor in a group of 3 - 5 people.
